


Make Connection

Students, you already know how to determine the opposite of a number. Now, we will use the opposite of numbers to add and subtract numbers.

Addition means to put together.

- On a number line, the **sum** of two numbers is the **location** after moving from the **first addend** a **distance** of the **second addend**.

Subtraction means to add the **opposite**.




